**Fun Facts about Blood
From Your American Cross!**

- The American Red Cross supplies about one-half of all blood products used in the country.
- Persons 65 years and other compose 13 percent of the population, but use 25 percent of all blood units transfused
- Newborn babies only have about one cup of blood in their bodies.
- Eating iron-rich food and drinking water can improve your blood donation experience.
- Donated blood is broken down into its three main components: red cells, platelets and plasma.
- Red blood cells can be stored for 42 days and platelets for only 5 days.
- You can give blood every 56 days
- All donated blood goes through testing for HIV, hepatitis and other diseases.
- Type O negative blood can be transfused to 100% of people.
- Type O positive is the most common blood type.
- There is still no substitute for human blood.
