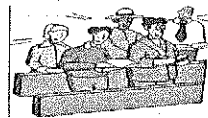

Little Johnny's Corner

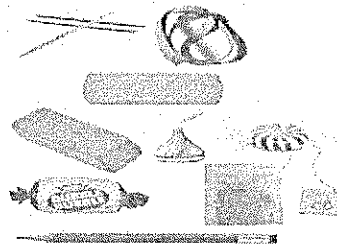


"Little Johnny's sucking his thumb"
