Ephesians 1: 13-14

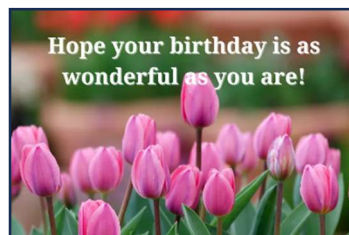
